Eric Cook is the voice of this video and at the 1:06 mark he underscores that 10% of the offering is returned to local associations to use for missions as God leads them. We are praying that God will lead our churches to double the NCMO in the next five years and therefore the amount we share with associations doubles

Many churches think that Baptists on Mission (BOM) is funded by the Cooperative Program, but 100% of BOM's regular budget comes from the NCMO. Disaster Relief is largely supported through designated gifts. While churches and individuals may contribute anytime, after the September emphasis we receive more than 75% of the funds donated to the NCMO.
